

## **Ladies Circle Israel – semi-annual activity summary**

### **Ladies Circle #29 – Jerusalem**

"Beit Ariel" hostel – a house for teenage girls between 13 and 18 that were taken out of their homes by court order. We meet with the girls twice a month and organize activities under the topic "women empowering".

"HaChot Hamesholash" Hostel – a house for runaways from the age 18 to 24 that have gone through sexual abuse. The activities includes providing food to needy families and are under the topic "women empowering".

"Mofet" club – a club for holocaust survivors – we arrange fun workshops customized to the elderly.

"Beit Giora" – a house for lonely soldiers. We cook for the soldiers once a week.

In addition, we organize various activities before holidays for the local community.

### **Ladies Circle #1 – Raanana**

"Beit Moreshet" club – a club for holocaust survivors - we celebrate their birthdays and arrange fun activities such as taking them to the theater.

"Neve Horim" – a house for the elderly. Once a month we arrange a fun workshop customized to the elderly such as flower decorating, Holiday activities etc.

"Kedar House" - House for residents with developmental disabilities whom live in the community and function independently. The social activity that was organized for them were Netball tournament once in 2 months and jeep trip across the country.

### **Ladies Circle #16 – Hod HaSharon**

"Makom Balev" community center – we organize activities for teenage girls at the center.

Hugging the invisible people – we make sure that the invisible people cleaning the streets in the morning receive a hot cup of tea, cake and a big smile.

"Beit Hashachaf" Hostel – a house for teenage at risk, we cook once a week for the teenagers and organize birthday parties for them.

We bake cakes for soldiers coming home for the weekend.

### **Ladies Circle #27 - Naharia**

"Yes & No team" – We organized a biking team combining blind and non-blind people. The team is riding on Tandem bicycles that require two people.

"Tzalash Project" – a project preparing woman for military service. We participate in the project by packing bags for the woman that includes all the necessary equipment.
